

HOUSE WINES

Viña Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc. Chile £15.95 175ml Glass - £4.45

Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity.

Viña Carrasco Merlot. Chile £15.95 175ml Glass - £4.45

Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel, with soft, mature tannins and a rounded, easy style.

Marques de Calado Rosé. Spain £15.95 175ml Glass - £4.45

An intense pink wine with plenty of juicy berry fruit. Strawberry and raspberry flavours are complemented by a creamy texture and crisp, refreshing acidity.

WHITES

'Crisp and Refreshing'

Alfredini Garganega Pinot Grigio. Italy £16.95

Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp and with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.

Picpoul Plo d'Isabelle, Picpoul de Pinet. South of France £23.95

Youthfully pale lemon yellow, with a nose of lemon and lime fruit, and an intriguing blend of white blossom and green herb notes. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish.

Jackson Estate 'Stich' Sauvignon Blanc. Marlborough, New Zealand £29.95

Elegant and vibrant nose of passionfruit, ripe citrus and hints of elderflower, a resonant palate with gooseberries, rhubarb and mineral notes, great texture and long finish.

'Aromatic'

Marqués de Cáceres Rioja Blanco. Rioja, Spain £21.95

A hugely aromatic wine expressing intense flavours of apples and pears with a light floral background. On the palate a freshness and vivacity comes through with an additional handful of lavish fruit.

Kuhlmann-Platz Riesling, Cave de Hunawih. Alsace £23.95

A Pale straw yellow, this wine is a classic Alsace Riesling, showing ripe pear and peach fruit, braced by a steely acidity.

Waimea Estate Gewürztraminer. Nelson, New Zealand £31.95

An intense, tropical-fruit-laden wine, full of concentrated flavours of orange zest and lychee, embellished with floral notes on the nose and a delicate yet slightly unctuous texture.

'Rich and Fruity'

Pierre-Jean Sauvion Chenin Blanc. Loire, France £22.95
A light-bodied, fresh and off-dry Chenin, with subtle aromas of white flowers and honey against a backdrop of crisp white apple. Lively acidity provides a mouthwatering experience.

Yalumba Y Series Viognier. Australia £21.95
This is a full-bodied dry white, with a gorgeously perfumed floral scent and a ripe, peach and apricot fruit, with a silky palate-feel.

Santa Rita Medalla Real Chardonnay. Leyda Valley, Chile £22.95
Bright golden in colour, with a faint green tint. The nose offers good ripeness, with citrus aromas turning to a softer, more apple and stone fruit character. Weighty and creamy on the palate.

REDS

'Light and easy-drinking'

Torre Cerere Montepulciano d'Abruzzo. Italy £16.95
This is a soft, fruity approachable red wine produced from Montepulciano grapes. With notes of warm plum and blackberry fruits, this easy drinking red is perfect served with hearty pasta dishes.

First Class Pinot Noir. Chile £18.95
Jam-packed with red fruits on both nose and palate, this Pinot Noir is awash with raspberry, strawberry and redcurrant fruit, framed by supple tannins and gentle hints of floral and pepper.

Fleurie, Georges Duboeuf. Beaujolais, France £23.95
Classic Fleurie with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume. Concentrated fruit and light tannic presence are testament to the cru status of this wine. An attractive wine with a silky texture.

'Soft and fruity'

Rioja Reserva, Viña Eguía. Rioja, Spain £16.95
Beautifully deep ruby coloured, with subtle cedar hints to the rim. The bouquet is an intense mix of dark fruit, toasted oak and clove aromas. The palate has weight yet an elegant profile.

Beauté du Sud Malbec. South of France £21.95
This modern Malbec echoes both the Old World rusticity of Southern France, and the inky fruitiness found in the Malbecs of Argentina and the rest of the New World.

La Vieille Capitelle. Languedoc, France £21.95
A well-structured middleweight red, offering a supple blend of cassis and mulberry fruit, nuanced on the nose by notes of wild thyme and leathery spice, and softened by a hint of French oak.

'Rich and Full-Bodied'

Parcel Series Shiraz £16.95
Bright and vibrantly fruity with good concentration, enhanced by lifted spicy aromas, and subtle hints of forest floor and tapenade-like savoury notes.

Flor del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon. Central Valley, Chile £21.95
Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy-going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.

Santa Rita Medalla Real Carmenère. Colchagua Valley, Chile £24.95
Plush and full bodied, this wine offers the nose and palate an array of blueberry, plum and oak-softened cassis fruit, accented with intriguing coffee and dark chocolate aromas.

ROSÉ

Blushmore Zinfandel Rosé £19.95
A medium-dry rose with ripe red fruits and a touch of sweetness to soften the palate.

Pinot Grigio Rosé Le Colline di San Giorgio, Breganze. Italy £19.95
Fresh fruit, such as apricot and peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish. Excellent with appetizers, fish dishes, soups and white meat.

CLASSICS

Chablis, Vocoret. Burgundy, France £34.95
Steely and minerally aromas with citrus fruits, limestone, slate and a crisp, fresh and vibrant palate of stony fruits, limestone, grapefruit and lemons, finishing on a racy and uplifting citrus kick.

Sancerre Vieilles Vignes Paul Cherrier et Fils. Loire, France £32.95
Quintessential Sancerre flavours of lemon, grapefruit, passion fruit and gooseberry with a racy minerality.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Puits Neuf. Rhone, France £44.95
With typical Chateauneuf power, the wine delivers a fresh and spicy nose of red cherry embellished with notes of sage and wild thyme. The palate is equally powerful, with sinuous tannins and huge length.

Esprit de Lussac, Lussac St-Emilion. Bordeaux, France £39.95
This is a rich, full bodied wine showing great concentration of flavour. With juicy black fruit on the nose and palate backed up by a smoky sandalwood character.

SPARKLING

Prosecco Corte Alta, DOC £19.95 Glass - £5.95
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

Prosecco La Marca Cuvée, DOCG £26.95
Delicate and elegant with a distinctive aroma of apple and apricot. Medium bodied, soft, velvety and well-balanced.

CHAMPAGNE

Canard-Duchêne Brut NV £44.95
Excellent value for this fabulous and well-respected Champagne. Clean and fruity in style, with baked-bread and bruised-apple notes, fresh and easy drinking.

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV £59.95
Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.

Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV £85.00
Unusually made by the saignée method, with plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm. A wonderfully refreshing apéritif, it also works well with a variety of dishes.

Bollinger Grande Année £139.95
Only Produced in exceptional years from Grand Cru and Premier Cru rated grapes. Rich, biscuit and yeasty, this wine carries the ultimate expression of the house style.
